This policy describes how Phon Tech Industrial Company ("Phon Tech" "we" or "us"), will collect and make use of your data when you visit or submit data to us via our website <u>www.phon-tech.com.tw</u>.

Part 1: Applicable to All Users

What Information Do We Collect?

We collect and process personal data about you when you submit data to us via our website or otherwise interact with us and when you use our websites. This includes:

- your name and the organization that you work for;
- your job title, division, email address, phone and/or other contact details you may provide to us;
- interests that you have expressed to us (e.g., in materials or processes or in speaking with specific contacts or roles within Phon Tech);

How Do We Use This Information, and What is the Legal Basis for This Use?

 - we place cookies and use similar technologies in accordance with our Cookies Policy, as set out below, and the information provided to you when those technologies are used;
 - \circ on other occasions where we ask you for consent, we will use the data for the purpose which we explain at that time.
- For purposes which are required by law:
 - In response to requests by government or law enforcement authorities conducting an investigation.

Withdrawing Consent or Otherwise Objecting to Direct Marketing

Wherever we rely on your consent, you will always be able to withdraw that consent, although we may have other legal grounds for processing your data for other purposes, such as those set out above.

You have an absolute right to opt-out of direct marketing at any time. You can do this by following the instructions in the communication where this is an electronic message, or by contacting us using the details set out below.

Who Will We Share This Data With, Where and When?

Depending on the nature of your request, we may decide that within our distribution system a distributor, rather than Phon Tech, is best suited to help you. In this case, we will ask for your consent to share your personal data with one of our distributors in order for the distributor to respond to your request.

Personal data will also be shared with third party service providers, who will process it on behalf of Phon Tech for the purposes identified above. In particular, we use third party service providers of website hosting and maintenance services and marketing agencies for digital marketing and automation services.

Which Entity is My Data Controller?

The data controller for your information is Phon Tech Industrial Company.

How Long Will You Retain My Data?

Where we process personal data for marketing purposes or with your consent, we process the data until you ask us to stop and for a short period after this (to allow us to implement your requests). We also keep a record of the fact that you have asked us not to send you direct marketing or to process your data so that we can respect your request in future.

In any case, we will not retain or use your personal information longer than necessary for the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy.

Cookie Policy

We use cookies to collect information about your online preference. Cookies are small pieces of information sent by a web server to a web browser which allows the server to uniquely identify the browser on each page.

We use the following categories of cookies on our website:

Strictly Necessary Cookies

What rights do I have?
